THE STANBIC GREENTECH ACCELERATOR **PROGRAM**

What is the Stanbic GreenTech Accelerator **Programme?**

The Stanbic GreenTech Accelerator is a two-year initiative co-implemented by Stanbic Business Incubator Ltd (SBIL) and the Embassy of France in Uganda. It supports youth and women-led green enterprises to scale their impact in sectors such as renewable energy, sustainable agriculture, waste management, circular economy, green mobility, water, health, and natural resource management.

Who is eligible to apply?

To be eligible, your enterprise must:

- Be youth and women-led (owner aged 18-35 years)
- Be legally registered and operational in Uganda for at least 2 years
- Have an annual turnover of at least UGX 50M for the past 2
- · Employ at least 2 full-time staff
- Operate in one or more of the targeted green sectors
- · Have financial records and a verified bank statement for the last 12 months

Which regions does the programme target?

The programme targets enterprises located in Hoima District and the Central Region districts of Kampala.

What is the duration of the programme?

The accelerator runs for 6 months overall, including 3 months of intensive training followed by mentorship, coaching, and business development support.

How many businesses will be supported?

The programme will support 130 growth-stage enterprises over two years:

- · Year 1: 2 cohorts. 25 SMEs each
- · Year 2: 2 cohorts, 20 SMEs each

What kind of support will participants receive?

Participants will benefit from:

• Diagnostics: Assess governance, strategy, systems, HR, marketing, and finance

- · Growth Planning: Strategic visioning and business model refinement
- Training & Mentorship: Delivered virtually and in-person, with 20% training and 80% coaching via the SBIL framework
- Expert Coaching: Two coaches per 5 enterprises
- Key Outputs: Growth plans, financial models, valuation reports, pitch decks, optimized business models, and core operational

How are participants selected?

Selection begins with submission of Expression of Interest (EOI) forms. This is followed by:

- Screening & Verification: Desk review of submitted documents
- Detailed Due Diligence: Site visits and validation of financial data
- Evaluation by an expert panel from the green economy, finance, and business sectors
- Inclusion Targets: At least 50% women-led and 30% youth-led enterprises
- · Outcome: A credible, high-potential enterprise cohort
