THE STANBIC **GREENTECH** ACCELERATOR PROGRAM

What is the Stanbic GreenTech Incubator Program?

The Stanbic GreenTech Incubator Programme is a two-year initiative co-implemented by Stanbic Business Incubator Ltd (SBIL) and the Embassy of France in Uganda. It supports early-stage youth- and women-led innovators developing green technologies in Uganda.

Who is eligible to apply?

Applicants must be women or youth aged **18–35 years**, living in Uganda. They must be based in the **Kampala Metropolitan Area** or the **Albertine Region (Hoima)** and have a greentech innovative idea or pilot in one of the following sectors: Sustainable Agriculture, Waste Management, Renewable Energy, Circular Economy, or Biomass.

What is the duration of the programme?

The duration of the program is **6 months**, overall. 3 months of intensive training and 3 months of continued coaching, mentorship, and incubation support.

How many businesses will be supported?

The programme will support **70 early-stage innovators** across two years:

What kind of support will participants receive?

Participants will benefit from a comprehensive **Business Development Support (BDS) Package**, which includes:

- **Needs Assessment:** Tailored assessment to identify specific support needs for product development and market readiness.
- **Training, Coaching & Mentorship:** A 6-month support programme delivered through physical, virtual, and site-based formats, focusing on:
- **Green economy principles:**
 - Governance and strategy

- Investment readiness
- Digitization and operational efficiency
- Linkage to Incubation Facilities
- Linkages to Stanbic Bank Green Financing Portfolio and other funding sources across the green ecosystem.

How are participants selected?

Stage 1: Expression of Interest (EOI) Submission

Applicants submit an EOI form detailing their background, innovation, and sector relevance.

Stage 2: Pitching & Selection

A 2-day pitching event is organized by SBIL for each cohort. Innovations are evaluated by a selection panel of experts in Green Economy, Finance, and Business, in consultation with the French Embassy.

Stage 3: Screening & Due Diligence

Due Diligence is conducted using Stanbic's Third Party Risk Management (TPRM) framework. Integrity Checks focus on character, criminal records, and global sanctions to ensure credibility.

Outcome: A final cohort of credible, high-potential innovators is selected to receive incubation support.

Which regions does the programme target?

The programme targets innovators based in **Hoima District** and the Central Region districts of **Kampala**.

Complete the Expression of Interest form online. Submit all required documents including your innovative idea description and any supporting materials.
